

Haluk Geray

Haluk Geray graduated from Ankara University, School of Journalism and Broadcasting. Geray received his masters and Ph.D degrees from Ankara University Faculty of Political Science's Political Science and Public Administration department. After working as a practicing journalist between 1992-1995, Geray joined Faculty of Communication at Ankara University where he continues to serve as Professor of Journalism. Geray represented Turkey, at OECD Computer and Commmunications Policy working group between 1997-2000. He worked as researcher at Information Technologies Institute (BILTEN) of Turkey's Scientific and Technological Institution (TÜBİTAK) between 1997-2000 as chief expert. He was then transferred to TÜBİTAK's Science and Technology Policies Department as chief researcher between 2001–2004 for initiating Turkey's first national technology foresight project, Vision 2023. He was contact point for Turkey in two European Unions Framework Programme's foresight projects: Foresight for Society (ForSociety) and Manufacturing Visions (ManVis). Haluk Geray served as Dean of Communication Faculty of Ankara University, between 2007–2010. As head of Distance Education Centre of Ankara University between 2011-2014, he renewed distance education infrastructure of the University. His main interest has been analyzing, introduction and implementation of digital networks in developing countries besides political economy of communication networks and media.
